

## Online Learning

Dear all

In view of the Prime Minister's and Premier's update in the last twenty-four hours there are some further changes to be discussed from my earlier Principal's update.

Mosman High School remains open for students.

However the Premier has indicated that families can keep their students at home where the parent is able to provide supervision.

At Mosman High all teachers have given access to learning for their classes using Google classroom. This learning platform enables work covered in class to be posted, assignments submitted and feedback given and is a two way communication between the students and the teacher.

A number of faculties also use Education Perfect particularly maths, science and languages and work can be set via Google classroom to students who would then complete this work online using Education Perfect.

The maths faculty have also videoed many of their lessons and these will be uploaded via Google classroom for students.

The executive had a meeting before school this morning to discuss how the day for students and teachers would look if we transition to fully online teaching and learning. This may mean that students at home follow their normal timetable with recess and lunch breaks and work through lessons sent via Google classroom.

We will be holding another executive meeting tomorrow at 7.30am to further look to supporting a fully online platform.

Further all teachers will receive Professional Learning after school on Wednesday as to how best to embed their teaching practice into the online platform.

For those students who are attending school we have staggered recess and lunch which at recess seemed to work well. Classrooms have desks separated so that we can train our students regarding social distancing and I have been able to get bulk mounted sanitisers to be placed around the school for student and staff use.

I will keep you updated as any changes occur.
